About the Information Briefing

This 1.25 hour session is aimed at briefing Headteachers, Senior Leaders, SENDCO's, family support workers, pastoral leads and other senior colleagues interested in exploring ways to support children who's learning has been interrupted by trauma and attachment difficulties. TISUK supports schools and organisations to create a culture where the mental health of all members of the community are supported.

The session will be delivered by Julie Harmieson - Co-Director of TISUK

The **aim of the session** is to offer an understanding of how schools can provide an environment of psychological safety that supports all, through enriched relational environments and a mentally healthy culture to buffer the impact of the high levels of stress caused by Adverse Childhood Experiences. Delegates will have an understanding of the underpinning theories and evidence base to trauma and mental health informed approaches; an introduction to the models, relational and conversational skills that structure our approach and an understanding of whole school culture in providing a trauma informed and mentally healthy environment to maximise engagement in life and learning for **all** children.

There will also be an opportunity to explore Motional, an easy-to-use online tool for identifying, assessing, and improving the emotional health and wellbeing of children and young people.

The session is appropriate for those working in both Primary and Secondary age phases.

There is no cost to this event, however, it is essential to book a place. We have a maximum capacity for 30 at this event, places will be granted on a first come, first served basis.
